AIRCRAFT HIRE

Aircraft available for hire from Hawera Aero Club are a C152 and 2x C172. We are aiming to have at least one other C152 and C172, a PA38, and possibly an Alpha. The more people who fly to the Rally, the easier and smoother competitions will run.

FUEL

Fuel is available, but needs to be paid for at the time of purchase. EFTPOS and internet banking are available. There will be a local refueling assistant on the day.

Shuttle transport for the weekend is \$20 and covers:

Please advise flight number, arrival/departure time and a mobile number so we can schedule pickups. We will try and take a group of people at a time, so you may have a short wait. However, New Plymouth has a brand-new terminal, with Jim Hickey's Airpresso café.

Should you require a pickup or drop off on different days, please just let us know and we'll be able to arrange something.

DETAILS

FRIDAY [NZAWA Registration and Information Desk will be open from midday at the HAWERA AERO CLUB](#)

Light aircraft fly in to Hawera. Pickups from NP airport at various times. Travel time by road is about an hour.

Starting 1730, it's an informal welcome at the Hawera Aero Club. Catch up with old friends, meet new members and talk about the day's flying.

Judges' briefing at 0800

Transport for air judges and ground judges depart accommodation from 0730. **Compulsory for all judges to attend.**

Competitor briefing at 0830

Transport for competitors depart accommodation from 0800. This briefing will cover the weather, safety considerations, judges and competitors' various responsibilities, competition procedures, aircraft hire arrangements and any questions. **Compulsory for all competitors to attend.**

Competitions start at 0900

For non-competitors shuttle transport will be available later.

Gliding competitions will be held at Stratford airfield (NZSD).

A separate briefing and transport will be arranged – further details to follow. If anyone would like to try gliding, please let us know, as we'd love for some of you to experience this different form of flight.

Tea and coffee is available all day. Lunch 1130-1330. A coffee cart will be onsite most of the day.

While we encourage as many people as possible to compete, we understand that a whole day at the airfield can be a bit much for some. If you're interested in checking out local sights (see list below for some suggestions) we can arrange transport.

SATURDAY EVENING

Transport 1745 to Ohangai for an 1800 start. Country and Western theme, so even if you're not into dressing up, throw on a cowboy hat and boots!

SUNDAY

The NZAWA AGM will be held at the Hawera Aero Club at 0900. Transport from 0845. A group photograph will be taken following the meeting.

A free afternoon gives you many local options:

- **Local flying.** If weather permits, check out the Summit of Taranaki Mouna.

- **Rotokare Scenic Reserve** www.rotokare.org.nz

A predator-free sanctuary filled with many native bird species, including kiwi, tieke and hihi. Just a short drive from Eltham. Walk around the lake in about 1.5 hours. Free entry.

- **Tawhiti museum** www.tawhitimuseum.co.nz

Featuring life-sized historical scenes, this is a must for any visitor to Taranaki. \$40 entry

- **Dawson Falls**

The falls tumble over the end of a lava flow and are easily accessed via a short walk. Combine this with the highly popular and accessible Wilkies Pools track (suitable for most ability levels) for a slightly more active afternoon.

Get a group together and we'll sort transport. A rural pub lunch could be included with some of the above options, or else check out our local craft beer brewery Forgotten 43, in nearby Stratford. Stratford is also home to the Fenton Street Arts Collective, where one of the best gins in the country is distilled.
